- As Geographers we will exploring different islands. Particularly looking at the features of the Isle of Struay and St Lucia and comparing the similarities and differences.
- As designers we will be designing purposefully functional vehicles that could be used for transport on an Island.
- In Computing we will learn how to send and receive emails with attachments.
