





Pupil premium and free school meals

If your child is eligible for 'free school meals' and you register them for this, we'll receive extra funding called 'pupil premium'. We use this extra money to improve the educational provision and resources at the school.

With this money, St Mark's can provide the following for your child:

- additional staff to teach your child in smaller groups to focus closely on their learning needs;
- subsidise your child's extracurricular activities;
- subsidise peripatetic music lessons for your child;
- subsidise the purchase of additional resources or equipment for your child;
- subsidise educational and residential visits organised as part of the school curriculum

your child would also be eligible for a clothing grant of £25.00 per school year.
